## EXPLORE Tech Summer Camp – in person STEM Camp for Girls and Boys entering 7<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> Grades

### Summer 2021 Topic: Exploring Sensor Systems

How does a “smart home” work? What sensors, software and other technologies are used to do this? Participants will gain an understanding of sensor systems through hands-on learning, to form connections between software and hardware using an Arduino - a physical, programmable circuit board. Campers will also enjoy ‘unplugged’ activities each day. **Includes:** lunch daily from Mines Market, take-home kits, t-shirt
