2022 Sedalia Summer Experience

DUE: May 1, 2022

Dear Parent,

We are pleased and excited to invite your child to our Sedalia Summer Experience (SSE)!

WHAT: The Sedalia Summer Experience is a program offered here at Sedalia Elementary School. This is an opportunity for your child to build background knowledge and academic vocabulary for the coming school year while focusing on inquiry. Your child will benefit from the SSE program by participating in direct instruction, field trips, and multiple days of applying and creating projects to showcase their learning. We will integrate technology, strengthen our reading and writing skills, and collaborate with other students. The program includes weekly field trips to further explore the world around us. Sedalia teachers will teach this program.

WHY: Over long breaks, many children lose achievement gains they made during the school year. This is commonly known as the summer slide. The SSE is designed to help lessen or offset the summer slide by engaging students during a three-week period focused on project-based learning. A three-week commitment is necessary.

WHERE: Sedalia Elementary will be having some work done this summer so we need to change locations. We will be at Castle Rock Middle School – CRMS.

Estamos complacidos y emocionados de invitar a su hijo a nuestra Sedalia Summer Experience (SSE)!

QUÉ: La Experiencia de Verano de Sedalia es un programa que se ofrece en la Escuela Primaria Sedalia. Esta es una oportunidad para que su hijo desarrolle conocimientos básicos y vocabulario académico para el próximo año escolar mientras se enfoca en la indagación. 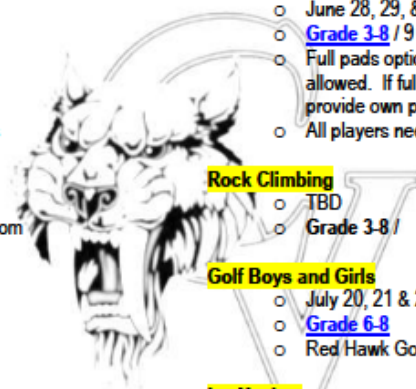

One week of Overnight Camp is \$1,075, with a deposit of \$325. One week of Day Camp is \$435, with a deposit of \$135.

COVID Mitigation Guidelines

Below is a summary of the guidelines we anticipate adhering to this summer. **Guidelines and protocols are subject to change as we continue to monitor guidance from the CDC and state and local health departments.**

- Increased cleaning: Stone Canyon will disinfect and clean all equipment and common spaces between camper use
- Pre-camp and daily health screenings: Staff and campers will pre-screen using a written record two weeks before camp. On arrival day and each subsequent day, campers will undergo a health screening.
- Required negative COVID test: All overnight campers are required to test for COVID 24-72 hours prior to their arrival at Stone Canyon, regardless of vaccination status (subject to change based on cases). An official print-out of the campers' test results must be brought to check-in. Day campers are not required to test for COVID.
- Cohorts: At this time we are not anticipating keeping campers in
