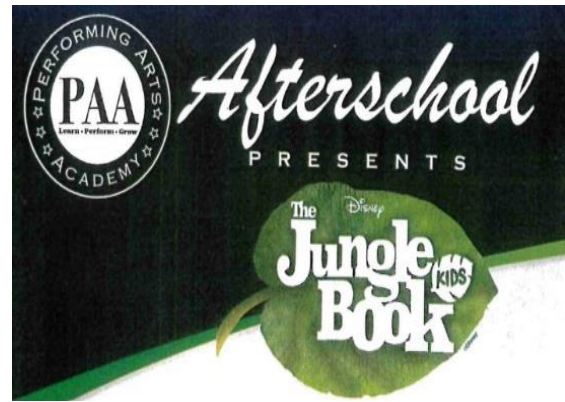

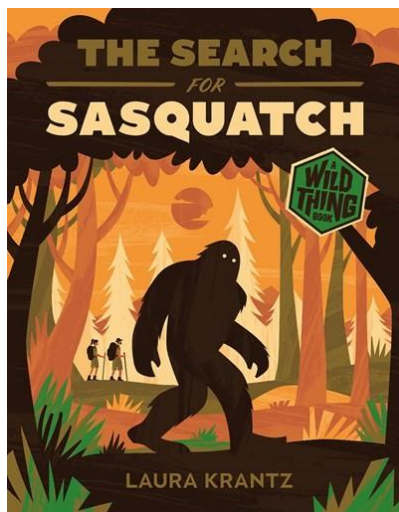
ATTENTION 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th Graders!

2022 Mill Levy Override and Bond Proposal

The Douglas County School District's Board of Education recently voted to place a **\$60 million Mill Levy Override (MLO)** and **\$450 million Bond** on the November ballot. If passed by voters, this is how the additional funds would be invested in our school.

Mill Levy Override dollars would enable us to:

- **Make teacher and staff pay more competitive with neighboring school districts.**
- **DCSD teachers, on average, would receive a 9% pay increase.**

Bond dollars would enable us to make much needed repairs and improvements to our building:

- **Replace flooring**
- **Install new intercom system**
- **Replace entrance heaters**
