Sedalia Summer Experience 2023

We are pleased and excited to invite your child to our Sedalia Summer Experience (SSE)!

Please fill out this form before May 5, 2023 Reminder: A three-week commitment is necessary.

WHAT: The Sedalia Summer Experience is a program offered here at Sedalia Elementary School. This is an opportunity for your child to build background knowledge and academic vocabulary for the coming school year while focusing on inquiry. Your child will benefit from the SSE program by participating in direct instruction, field trips, and multiple days of applying and creating projects to showcase their learning. We will integrate technology, strengthen our reading and writing skills, and collaborate with other students. The program includes weekly field trips to further explore the world around us. Sedalia teachers will teach this program.

WHY: Over long breaks, many children lose achievement gains they made during the school year. This is commonly known as the summer slide. The SSE is designed to help lessen or offset the summer slide by engaging students during a three-week period focused on project-based learning. A three-week commitment is necessary.


